



MUSEUM GUIDELINES

1. **DO NOT TOUCH THE ART WORK.** We know that the artwork at the American Visionary Art Museum doesn't look like artwork you have seen at other museums or maybe anywhere in the world. But it is still delicate and rare and can be easily harmed by touching, so please don't do it.
2. **DO NOT RUN IN THE MUSEUM.** There is no rush. You will have time to see everything. Running leads to accidents and crashing into artwork, so please just walk through the museum.
3. **DO NOT YELL.** We want to make sure everyone at the museum enjoys his or her visit, there is no reason to shout at the museum.
4. **DO NOT EAT OR DRINK INSIDE.** We mean this, no eating or drinking in any part of the museum. We want to protect the artwork. Please leave any food and beverages on your bus, or at the front desk and only munch on them outside.
5. **DO NOT TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS INSIDE.** When we say no pictures inside, this means camera phones too! You can feel free to take photos outside of the museum if you would like. You can also feel free to draw and sketch as much as you would like both inside and outside.

If you or your group is not able to follow these guidelines, a museum guard will kindly ask you to leave the museum.
